



HOUSE RULES

Important: (House Rules may have already been modified and may take sometime to update on web-site official [House Rules](#) are located at the centre)(01172012)

1. Customers' must be 18 years of age or older enter the gaming area /floor. Valid government issued Photo I.D.
2. Admittance will not be permitted if not wearing shirt or shoes.
3. Minimum purchase of strips posted of the [Regular Bingo Book](#) is required.
4. Customers' must purchase a [Regular Bingo Book](#) to play the super or accumulator games.
5. All customers must have an account and a receipt of purchase to be eligible for any prizes for each session.
6. Each Customer can choose to play up to one (1) WAT account in each currency.
7. Each WAT account is independent of one another and the minimum purchases are required for each WAT account.
8. Customer's can only play one (1) electronic device at any one time.
9. Wins are limited to one winning pattern per bingo card face.
10. The last chance to buy a [Big "5"](#) ticket will be the start of the first (1st.) round of the [Regular Bingo Book](#).
11. The last chance to purchase a [Mini Progressive](#) book will be the second (2nd.) round of the [Mini Progressive](#) book.
12. The last chance to buy a [Regular Bingo Book](#) will be the first number called of the third (3rd.) round of the regular book.
13. The last chance to purchase any [Special Games](#) will be the first number called of that [Special Game](#).
14. Customers' must purchase at least minimum books posted in [US currency](#) in order to purchase [US Specials](#). If you bingo on a card and do not have the minimum [US Regular Bingo Book](#) purchased, you will be paid in [Canadian currency](#).
15. In order to be paid in [US currency](#), you must have made all of your purchases in [US currency from the Big "5" pot through to the Jackpot round](#), your original receipt must be provided at time of cash out.

16. **Electronic players** do not need to cash out each session but can use their credits to make purchases for the next session.
17. No splitting, cutting or sharing of any bingo books/cards. Bingos on split books/cards will not be honored.
18. Bingo books/cards can only be played at the session they were purchased from. They must not be used at other bingo sessions.
19. The centre is not responsible for duplicate cards.
20. Management reserves the right to refuse sales of books/cards.
21. Dabbers must be used on your bingo paper for bingo to be recognized.
22. We play on deck bingo, which means the ball is not in play until the caller has verbally announced the number.
23. It is the **players responsibility** to **notify** the caller whether verbally (**shouting bingo**) or **mechanically** to ensure the caller stops the game in the event of a potential bingo.
24. A missed bingo after a game has been closed will not be honored.
25. Once a game is closed, it cannot be re-opened, unless the closed bingo is deemed to be invalid.
26. The **maximum** purchase of the posted **strips is 12** for the **electronic units**.
27. Electronic Bingo Units do replace the use of bingo paper and dabbers. Bingos will be verified from the electronic units.
28. To win the **Big "5"** you must bingo using the posted number as your last number to complete the pre-announced pattern.
29. Customers must have proper I.D. to claim a **designated number prize, Big "5" Pot or any prize of \$1000.00 or more**.
30. The **Big "5" Pot** is paid in **either Canadian or American currencies**.
31. **Break Open** tickets prizes are paid in **Canadian currency** only.
32. Multiple claims will share equally the prize money to a minimum of \$5 each.
33. The bingo event is regulated by the **Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario** and managed and conducted by **Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation**. All terms and conditions of the games must be adhered to and will be enforced.
34. Cellular phones or pagers must be in silent mode while in the hall.
35. Management is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen articles.
36. Management reserves the right to refuse entry into the building.
37. Premises are under Surveillance.
